Did you know ... as the effects of inhalants begin to wear off, a person may experience effects such as headaches, nausea & dizziness. These effects can last for a number of days?

Did you know ... that those who use cannabis regularly can take up to three months to have negative urine drug tests?

Did you know ... that amyl nitrite is a clear, yellow, highly volatile and flammable liquid? The liquid smells sweet and fruity when fresh but like 'sweaty socks' when stale.

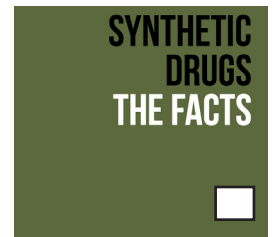
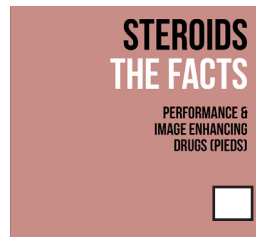
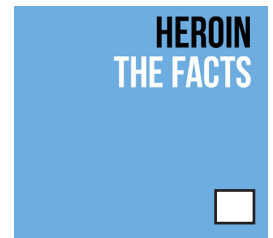
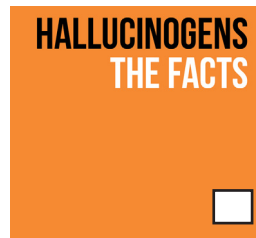
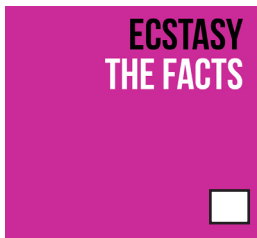
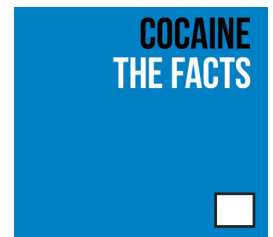
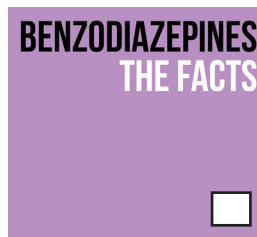
Bonus activity – get creative!
