- Statewide collection of culturally important local content
- Improved accessibility
  - Inbuilt PDF, EPUB, MP3 & MP4 readers for browser and IOS and Android Apps
  - Deep catalogue integration (SIRSI, Spydus, Libero & Aurora underway)
  - Create collection lists with persistent links for social media and eNewsletters)
- Free hosting
- Solution for services without a hosting platform (having a LS platform does not exclude you from using indyreads)

Born digital items or digitised items from your Local Studies Collection

- books and journals that have been published
- oral histories and transcripts (Amplify).

Only titles licensed for whole of state access will be considered.

### Formats:

- EPUB
- PDF
- MP3 (Audio)
- MP4 (Video)

### Out of scope

- Photographs
- Newspapers
- council records
- Unpublished material
- ephemera

- . Import Metadata from ONIX, Text File, and ISO 2709 (MARC 21) file formats.
- . You can use ISBN fields to cross reference data files like ePubs, PDFs or metadata files already in OdiloTK.
