# What is NED?

National edeposit (NED) is a shared collecting service that enables the deposit, description, preservation, access and delivery of digital publications.

It was launched in August 2019.

NED was developed by the National Library and the state and territory libraries over several years.

The idea was to have a portal where Australian publishers could deposit their legal deposit publications once only and so satisfy their legal deposit obligations to the national, state and territory libraries

# What is legal deposit?

Legal deposit is a legal requirement for publishers to deposit their works with a library in their jurisdiction

In Australia, there is legal deposit legislation at the national, state and territory level

The [Library Amendment Act 2019](#) requires that NSW publishers deposit their publications to three deposit libraries – the State Library of NSW, the NSW Parliamentary Library and the University of Sydney Library.

The [Premier’s Memorandum No. 2000 - 15, Access To Published Information - Laws, Policy and Guidelines](#) requires that NSW government publishers deposit their print and digital publications to three deposit libraries - the State Library of NSW (required to deposit two print copies), the NSW Parliamentary Library, and the University of Western Sydney Library.

The [Premier’s Memorandum M2013-09 Production Costs of Annual Reports](#) requires that NSW government publishers deposit their digital annual reports to NSW State Records and Archives – upload to OpenGov NSW, National Library of Australia, University of Western Sydney Library, State Library of NSW and the NSW Parliamentary Library.

Currently under review

The Commonwealth [Copyright Act 1968](#) requires that all Australian publishers (including NSW) deposit their publications in the National Library of Australia.

The [Commonwealth Library Deposit and Free Issue Schemes](#) (LDS) requires that Australian government publishers deposit their publications in National, state and territory libraries.

NED accepts books, serials, sheet music and maps that are legal deposit digital publications and are in common formats such as epub, mobi, pdf, and tiff.

Publishers can submit publication via the NED portal, establish depositing with email or FTP bulk deposit

Publishers enter metadata about the publication, the intellectual property and access conditions

## Encourage Publishers to deposit

- NED will provide permanent archive of their publications
- NED will enable access for all time to their publications
- Encourage open access

NED will accept all publications that are deposited where they meet criteria.

Where we ask publishers to deposit then depending upon the publisher will be what we ask for:

- Commercial publishers – everything
- Organisations, Community, Businesses, Government Agencies – the significant publications

Website material is collected with domain harvests so will capture material not in NED – hence focus on significant publications.

- Annual reports
- Newsletters, magazines, journals and bulletins
- Research reports and studies
- Commission and inquiry reports
- Budget papers
- Environmental impact statements
- Community consultation reports
- Discussion and issue papers
- Historical and heritage studies
- Maps
